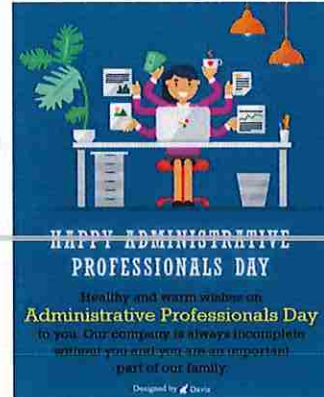
These ladies go above and beyond for our patients, and provide the upmost care and compassion. We salute you ladies for an amazing job well done!

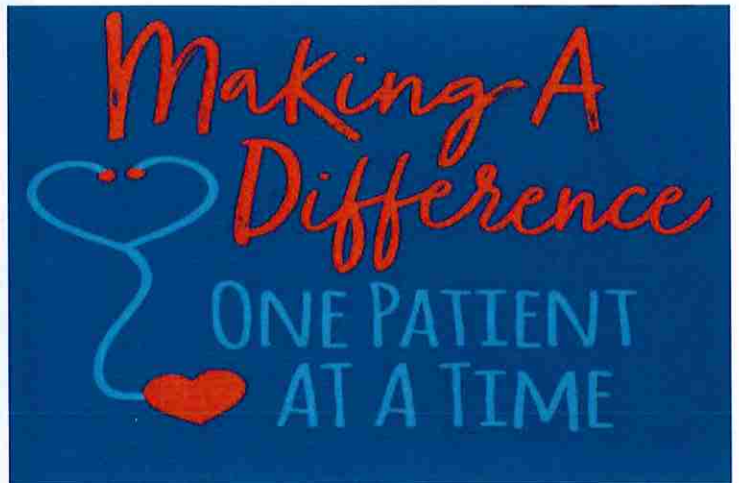

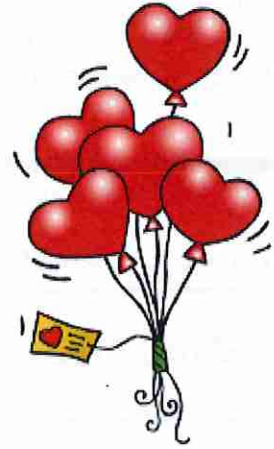
