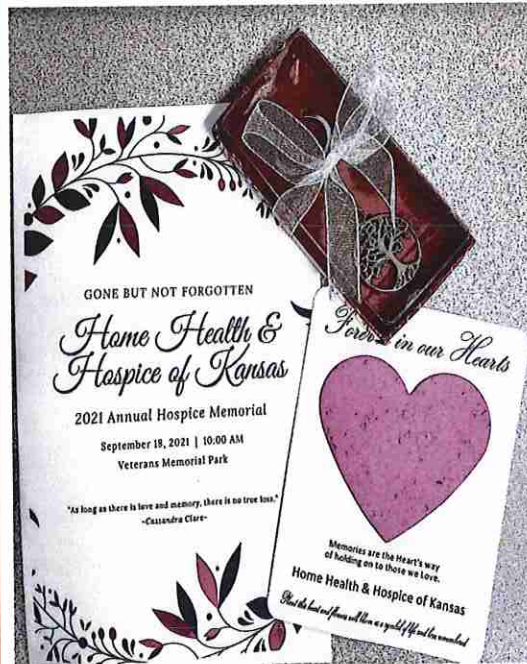

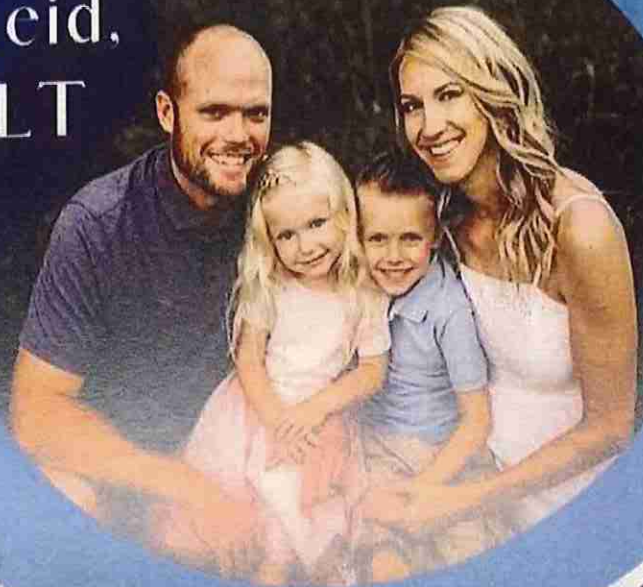
2021 Annual Hospice Memorial

Lymphedema is tissue swelling caused by an accumulation of fluid that is usually drained through the body's lymphatic system. It mostly commonly affects the arms or legs, but can also occur in the chest wall, abdomen, neck and genitals. There is no cure for lymphedema. The treatment focuses on reducing the swelling and preventing complications. (Mayo Clinic.org).
